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Local College and School (10 and 10+2) Students' Fellowship Programme

1. Preamble

In alignment with the JIGYASA scheme launched by the Government of India, IIPE will focus on mentoring and guiding students from nearby colleges and schools. IIPE faculty will be encouraged to deliver lectures at colleges and schools, conduct research training programs and invite students to the campus during Summer/Winter breaks. This will result in improvement of overall educational ecosystem of the local academic community. The Summer/Winter Fellowship program is open to local School (10 and 10+2) and College students and offers training for 2-4 weeks. The **LCS-SFP** at the IIPE provides an opportunity to the students of schools and colleges to get exposure in Fundamental concepts in STEM and basic experiment and computational techniques. The purpose of the LCS-SFP is to inspire the college and school students for a career in science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM).

2. Definitions

2.1 'Institute' refers to Indian Institute of Petroleum and Energy, Visakhapatnam.

2.1 'President' refers to President of Board of Governors of Institute.

2.2 'Faculty' refers to all permanent faculty members of Institute.

2.4 **'LCS-SFP Fellows'** refer to all applicants who were selected for the Fellowship Programme during that particular year.

3. Subject Areas of Training

3.1 One of the following subject area must be provided by the applicant while applying for Fellowship Programme.

3.2 All areas of: -

- a. Biosciences/Biotechnology/Bioinformatics
- b. Chemical Engineering
- c. Chemistry
- d. Computer Science and Engineering
- e. Earth Sciences
- f. Electrical Engineering
- g. Mathematics
- h. Mechanical Engineering
- i. Petroleum Engineering
- j. Energy and allied fields

4. Faculty and their area of expertise

Refer IIPE website (<u>https://www.iipe.ac.in/allfaculty</u>). Faculty preference may be provided by the applicant while applying for Fellowship. However, the faculty preference is subject to the availability of faculty during summer/winter vacation.

5. Number of Fellowship positions

A maximum of Fifty School/College students will be selected in an academic year.

6. Timeline of Internship

2-4 weeks during the summer/winter vacation as per academic calendar of the Institute. Usually the window of summer vacation is around 2 to 2.5 months.

7. Cost of Fellowship application

The applicants shall be required to pay an application fee of Rs. 100/- through Payment Gateway. Application fees once paid will not be refunded.

8. LCS-SFP selection committee

The application received by Office of Dean (R&D) will be forwarded to Departmentwise LCS-SFP selection Committees to recommend the applications. The Departmentwise LCS-SFP selection Committee is a three-member committee comprising of Head of the Department as Chairperson, Associate Dean of R&D, and One more faculty member from the concerned Department/Subject expert nominated by Dean of R&D.

9. Selection criteria

The applicant selection is based on marks scored in previous examinations and 1page writeup on why they are interested in the IIPE Student Fellowship Program.

10. Evaluation of Student Fellows

At the end of the training programme, all the LCS-SFP Fellows need to make a presentation of the work carried out, which is open to all IIPE academic community. A commendation certificate will be given to the LCS-SFP Fellows and they are encouraged to continue their collaboration with IIPE.

11. Other Guidelines

11.1 These SW-FLSC Guidelines and/or modifications shall take effect from the date the Presidentapproves.

11.2 Maximum of Twenty-Five LCS-SFP Fellows will be selected per Semester and a maximum of one LCS-SFP Fellow will be allowed under any particular faculty of IIPE.

11.3 The living/hostel/transport expenses have to be borne by the LCS-SFP Fellows. However, Rs. 2000/- will be paid to each SW-FLSC Fellow after the end of Fellowship program. Hostel facility will be provided for the outstation girl students.

11.4 It is advised to have a validmedical insurance policy during the period of training.

11.5 SW-FLSC Fellowship program is a mandatory 2-4week Fellowship programme. A

commendation/completion certificate will only be awarded after completion of 2-4 weeks of training. Any leave/late- joining allowed under special circumstances should be compensated by extended period of training beyond the last date.

11.6 All Student Fellows will be issued a temporary institute ID card to avail the library, sports, computer center, internet, and other institute and departmental research facilities. She/he will be required abide by the conduct rules of the institute, failing which the training will be terminated and the trainee will be asked to leave immediately.

11.7 Applications with all required documents need to be submitted on online portal availableon institute website. The applications are to be signed and stamped by the Principal of the School/College.
